February Worship and Second Hour Preview

February 4th: "Come and See as Jesus Sees", given the striking conversation Jesus has with the Samaritan woman in <u>John 4:1-42</u>, leaving both of them changed. We'll also receive communion in the pews. For Second Hour, we'll screen part of the PBS series *Race: The Power of an Illusion*. <u>The excerpt</u> highlights the connections between racial exclusion laws ("redlining") and poverty today.

February 11th: On this final Sunday of our "Come and See" Epiphany series, we uncover the role of Jesus in healing a man born blind, and the opposition he faces from religious authorities (John 9:1-41). Bring your bling--masks, boas, beads, etc--because this is our annual Mardi Gras service as well! Following worship, the Second Hour is our Pancake Breakfast fundraiser for youth at the Daylight School.

February 14th: Ash Wednesday falls on Valentine's Day this year, which is the perfect opportunity to begin Lent with those you love, especially Christ, who says, "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends" in John 15:1-17. We'll receive ashes as a reminder of life's brevity, but also share communion by intinction as a reminder of our undying connection to divine love through Christ.

February 18th: "No Greater Love" will be our focus throughout Lent, and it begins today with Jesus' words in John 10:1-18. Though sheep and people get lost or wander astray, the greater love of our Good Shepherd calls us back to his path. The Second Hour today (and throughout Lent) will be a brief time for quiet meditation in the sanctuary after worship.

February 18th (7pm):

Please join us every third Sunday at 7pm during the winter months for a warm and centering Taizé-style



worship service in the sanctuary. Our 30 minute, candlelit service of meditative songs, scripture and silence is followed by a simple soup supper in the library. Please join in; all are welcome!

February 25th: As we see from Jesus' encounter with a woman caught in adultery (<u>John 8:1-11</u>), the love of God transcends a fault-finding legalism, choosing freedom and new horizons instead. We also receive a special offering for Seminary Sunday, to support future leaders of the church.
